Art Class Specifics Regarding COVID-19

Policy & Procedures

All Art students & the instructor will abide by Aspire's COVID-19 Procedures & Policies as accepted by the KY Dept. of Public Health and adopted by the Aspire! Conservatory Board of Directors.

Room Specifics (per Aspire's COVID-19 Procedures & Policies)

1. Class size will be limited to 8 or less. More classes are being offered throughout the week, and we are also in the process of developing a virtual learning option.
2. Parents may escort their children to class but are not allowed to wait in the building during class. This is an effort to support social distancing and overcrowding. Parents with small children are welcome to give their phone number to the instructor so that the instructor or child can call you during class if a situation arises.
3. Art classrooms will be cleaned and disinfected before each class, and art supplies for the class will be pre-set in place before the class starts.
4. In addition to sanitizing their hands at check-in, students will be required to sanitize their hands upon entering the classroom. Because there are sinks in each art room, students will be allowed to wash their hands throughout class as needed/desired.
5. As an extra layer of protection and peace of mind, students will be given a disinfecting wipe when they enter the classroom so that they can re-wipe their personal learning space and chair before sitting down. Instructors may assist small children.
6. Parents should come to the classroom **5 minutes before the end** of class to walk their children out of the building. We do not want young children exiting the building alone.

Art Supplies

Per discussion with the KY Dept. of Public Health, there are some art supplies which are easily cleaned/sanitized and can be shared between classes, but not by

students in the same class. To avoid in class sharing, we will make sure that there are enough Aspire provided art supplies so that each student will have his/her own to use throughout the class period. Supplies will be disinfected after each use and stored in airtight containers.

Likewise, some art supplies **are not easily cleaned/sanitized**. Those items will need to be provided by the student. Each student is expected to bring an art bag/case with the listed supplies. These are items that most artistically inclined students have at home already, and they are not to be shared with others. Students will transport their personal art supplies between home and class each week. We will not be storing personal art supplies at the church.
